HIGH QUALITY ASSESSMENT PRACTICES

The current educational climate has given the word “assessment” a negative connotation. Educators have become concerned that students are not intrinsically motivated to reach their personal best as they struggle to balance “teaching to a test” and student burn out. Research shows, assessment practices that provide feedback, empower students to take ownership of their learning as they become more engaged and find value in the educational process.

During the High Quality Assessment Workshop educators will reevaluate the assessment process and begin to design assessments that create a classroom culture that fosters intrinsic motivation for students.

- Identify the characteristics of high quality assessment practices
- Begin to develop assessments that align with high quality assessment best practices
- Begin to develop a classroom framework that supports the high quality assessment process
